
## **PREVALENCE OF USE**

### ALCOHOL

While 30-day use trended downward for nearly all substances used among youth, the rate of underage drinking increased slightly. Underage drinking: (23.6% in 2021)

## TRENDS IN USE

This chart illustrates trends in prevalence of use; tobacco, Rx pain, and ecigarettes have decreased while alcohol and marijuana have increased.




## PREVALENCE OF USE NICOTINE

Trends show 30-day use has decreased slightly for nicotine. Cigarettes: (3.1% in 2021) E-cigarettes: (15.0% in 2021)
