

Short Social Media Skits

These scripts are a series of skits that were written for a bar during the initial shutdown for Covid.

The bar opened a couple of months prior to the shutdown, and they wanted to maintain engagement with their followers while everyone waited for businesses to reopen. They wanted super short humorous scripts that would grab people's attention quickly.

I've provided context for some skits since it would be hard to understand them without it.

Scripts

1. Context: The bar is a large beer garden with a substantial amount of outdoor seating/games. The ground outside is covered in AstroTurf.

Someone is laying down on the AstroTurf with a magnifying glass and a pair of tweezers in their hands. They are looking through the magnifying glass and acting like they are meticulously trimming the AstroTurf with the tweezers.	N/A	N/A

2. Context: There is a pickleball court at the bar.

Have someone sit cross-legged on the pickleball court and bounce a ball up and down on a racket sadly.	Play “The Sound of Silence” by Simon & Garfunkel in the background.	N/A

3. Context: The bar has a large gate that allows you to enter the outdoor section.

Visuals	Narration	Captions
Have someone stand in front of the locked gate and shake it back and forth. CUT TO...	N/A	N/A
The same person is now standing outside a grocery store. CUT TO...	They let out a big sigh.	Caption with “Friday night out!”
The same person is now at their kitchen counter. They are shaking a drink in a cocktail shaker, then they pour it into a glass.		
They walk around to the other side of the counter, pick up the drink, and “cheers” an imaginary person.		

4. **Context:** Pretty self-explanatory.
