O you who believe! Keep your duty to Allah and fear Him, always speak the truth. He will direct you to do righteous good deeds and will forgive you your sins. And whosoever obeys Allah and His Messenger has indeed achieved a great achievement" (Al Ahzab:70-71)

It also assists Muslims in preserving their chastity, allows them to enjoy	joy love, i	mercy, and sec	urity in a
permissible way. Marriage provides a permissible outlet to fulfill one's	natural d	esires, and to f	ollow the
ways of the Prophets and Messengers. Our beloved Prophet Muhamma	ad highly e	encouraged his	followers
to get married:			

يقول النبي صلى الله عليه وسلم:" يَا مَعْشَرَ الشَّبَابِ مَنِ اسْتَطَاعَ مِنْكُمُ الْبَاءَةَ فَلْيَتَزَوَّجْ فَإِنَّهُ أَغَضُّ لِلْبَصَرِ وَأَحْصَنُ لِلْفَرْجِ وَمَنْ لَمْ يَسْتَطِعْ فَعَلَيْهِ بالصَوْمِ فَإِنَّهُ لَهُ وَجَاءٌ " . رواه البخاري و مسلم

"O young men, whoever has the ability amongst you to get married, then let him do so. Marriage helps lower the gaze and preserves chastity. And whoever is not able then let him fast, for fasting is a restraint (for his desires)"

Marriage between male and female is from the sunnah of the Prophet Muhammad, as he tells us:

"Marriage is from my sunnah, whoever does not act upon my sunnah is not from me. Get married, for indeed I will outnumber the others by you all. Whoever has the ability then let him get married, and if he doesn't then let him fast, as it is a restraint for desires" (Sunan ibn Majah with a good chain)

Marriage safeguards our communities from moral degeneracy. Specifically it protects Muslims from slipping into 'Zina' and prohibited relationships between men and women.

There is a beautiful verse in the Quran that elaborates how a marriage can be successful and provides for us the two main pillars of a successful marriage:

"And from His signs is that He created for you spouses from among yourselves so that you may find comfort in them. And He has placed between you compassion and mercy. Surely in this are signs for people who reflect."

The two pillars of a successful married life are: Love and Mercy. They are two factors that brighten one's life and give one a feeling of reassurance, security and happiness. This is the successful balance to have in married life. Loving one's spouse and being merciful with them will bring them so close, like the closeness of a garment to a person's body. The two spouses act as a protection, comfort, warm and cover for one another, as Allah mentioned in the Quran:

"They are as garments for you and you are garments for them"

If newly married couples ponder and reflect over this verse, it will hopefully lead them to fulfilling each other's marital rights. Both spouses must try their best to fulfill these rights for the sake of Allah.

The Muslim man must fulfill the following rights for his wife:

- a) Dowry that demonstrates seriousness and the importance of the marriage contract and is a token to respect and honor the woman.
- b) Obligatory spending by providing what the wife needs of food and accommodation.
- c) Accommodation
- d) Fair and kind treatment
- e) Not harming one's wife

The Muslim woman must fulfill the following rights for her husband:

- f) Obedience, the man is the protector and maintainer of the woman in Islam.
- g) Making herself available to her husband, for intimacy when he requests
- h) Not allowing anyone in the house who the husband does not approve of
- i) Not leaving the house except with the husband's permission
- j) Fair and kind treatment

Muslim men should take the Prophet Muhammad as their example in how to be a good spouse, as he said:

"The best of you are those who are best with their families, and I am the best to my family" Sunan At-Tirmidthi

A Muslim husband should never mistreat his wife/wives. The Prophet Muhammad never spanked or hit a woman, he never complained about their food, he was always in service of his wives while he was at home with them. He always dealt with his wives using kind words, wisdom and patience. He advised his followers to be kind with women:

Allah 's Messenger said, "Treat women nicely, for a women is created from a rib, and the most curved portion of the rib is its upper portion, so, if you should try to straighten it, it will break, but if you leave it as it is, it will remain crooked. So treat women nicely." Saheehul Bukhari
