SUMMARY OF MY EXPERIENCE AND QUALIFICATIONS

I am a British Criminologist and former senior police officer with over 30 years' public service

experience, for most my career I worked as an operational detective and Senior Investigating Officer

(SIO), specialising in the investigation of Major and Specialist Crime. In the past, I have led

investigation teams investigating high profile complex cases and been commended for my detective

abilities and leadership by various Chief Constables, Judges and Public Safety Charities.

In 2006, I founded the Behavioural Analysis Unit (BAU) for the UK Child Exploitation Online

Protection Centre (CEOP). I ran the unit for 5 years promoting and expanding the use of Behavioural

Analysis techniques within law enforcement and child protection agencies worldwide. During this

time, I consulted on hundreds of serious sexual crimes against children many of which were high

profile cases. I have also worked with Interpol, Europol, American Department of Justice (DOJ),

Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and the United States Marshall's Service (USMC) as well

undertaking work for the British Foreign and Commonwealth Office in Southeast Asia and Eastern

Europe.

Since 2012 I have worked independently as a Criminologist and as a subject matter expert in relation

to the behaviour of adult perpetrators of child sexual abuse. My knowledge and expertise

concerning the behavioural aspects of perpetrators has developed over the course of my policing

career and the specialist roles I have held together with my academic research. I regularly, deliver

training internationally to a multidisciplinary audience on various aspects of my work. (See details of

contrubute to the media and as a TV presenter.

I am a member of the British Society of Criminology and a Visiting Research Fellow at Leeds

University School of Law; I hold a PhD in Criminology/Applied Social Science and a Post-Graduate

Certificate in Forensic Behavioural Psychology. My PhD research was at Durham University and

focused upon the behaviour of male non-familial child abductors that sexually abuse and murder
