#### A Little Bit of This and That for June 2025...

Where are the places that you find rest and restoration for your body and soul? Summer is so often meant to be the special time of the year when we take time to vacation and rest, but often life just seems to get more and more hectic. We have a hard time to be fully present in the situations we find ourselves. Often, we lose ourselves in the craziness of the demands that summer (and really any time of the year) can bring.

In June I will begin a four week preaching series on the **Sacred Art of Listening**. So often we get so busy that we do not take the time to carve out time to listen to God, to ourselves, to each other, and to our community. This will be our focus beginning June 11 and 15.

Taking time to be in tune with all four of these components is powerful for moving forward in faith and all of life in healthy ways.

I read recently in a book on listening that due to our constant ability to dial in to social media that many are truly losing the ability to listen to others, especially those who may have a different opinion than we do. Listening deeply is an art that takes time for us to clear our minds and not rehearse what we want to say while the other is talking, but is an art that when is done well can bring a deeper connection.

That is my hope in life with God and with myself and others. I desire to truly listen with a heart that is open to hear deeply and to respond in faith and love in a way that brings this deeper connection.

Have you ever looked when at a restaurant to see how many people are on their phones rather than talking and listening to the people they are with? It is kind of frightening that we let the demands of answering texts, emails, phone calls, gaming or Tik Tok take precedence of being fully present.

This summer you are invited to take time to listen in more intentional ways so that you can be more in tune with yourself, God and others. May God bless you as you carve our time to form deeper connections through listening deeply.

**Challenge for June:** Set your phone timer for 5-10 minutes and just sit in silence.

Notice what you hear, see, or feel? Choose some different settings – possibly outside your home, at a park or on a hiking trail. Notice: How hard is it for you to get quiet and just listen to yourself, God and your surroundings? Does carving out this time to listen bring a sense of calm and renewal to you?

#### **Summer Preaching Themes:**

For the last two years we have been using the Narrative Lectionary for our worship scriptures. The lectionary does not run in the summer in order to allow pastors to have more freedom to choose themes and scriptures for preaching and worship.

One of the joys in the summer is that Doug comes to Delphos to preach with me on Wednesday evenings and then I preach with him on Saturday evenings at St. Mark's in Wapakoneta. Therefore, we both will be preaching on the same themes. So, I have been consulting with Doug to come up with three themes that will begin the third week in June. Prior to that we will be preaching for several weeks on Galatians.

#### The Themes:

- 1. **Listening**: based on the book, "The Listening Life: Embracing.
- Attentiveness in a World of Distraction" by Adam S. McHugh. This is the designated year of listening by Bishop Beaudoin of our Northwestern Ohio Synod so it seems appropriate to spend some time preaching and learning about how to listen to God, ourselves, others, and our communities.
- 2. God's Gifts to a Chaotic World: Grace, Perseverance, Forgiveness and Blessings
- 3. **After I say I believe**, how do I attend to my faith in taking care of my time, talents, treasures, relationships and creation?

#### **Summer Wednesday Evening Services:**

This additional service begins the Wednesday before Memorial Day and runs into September as the weather and daylight permits. It is designed to allow those who will be away on the weekends to still have an opportunity to worship. Many, though, just like the opportunity to worship in a more relaxed setting outdoors.

Currently, the area in the courtyard where we normally hold the service is in the process of getting ready to have new concrete poured. Therefore, on May 21st, the worship service was to be held in the Parish Hall. If it takes a few more weeks to get the concrete poured, we will meet at the side of the church by the parking lot.

When the weather is rainy, we will meet in the Parish Hall.

This service is geared to be a little more informal and placed in a setting to enjoy the summer weather and avoid any excess heat that may be in the sanctuary in the evenings during the summer.

Also, it is a great service to invite a friend to as it is more relaxed in nature. People are invited to bring a lawn chair to enjoy sitting outside while worshipping together.

Please note that Sunday worship times are now changed to **9:00 AM starting on Memorial Day weekend** and will run through Labor Day weekend.

#### Other News:

#### **Maintenance:**

We have completely cleaned out the basement and crawl space areas by an outside company as well as having another company install 10 new LED lights in the crawl space for better access working conditions. We have installed four new outdoor spigots around the church to better enable the watering of our new landscape and to do general maintenance.

Concrete work is being done when the weather cooperates. Currently everything is prepped for the total area for concrete that was removed in order to install the new drain and sewer system. The front sidewalk in front of the parish hall will be replaced this summer as weather permits. Landon Calvelage has begun the work on his Eagle Scout project. He has power washed the concrete and sandstone as well as the entire sidewalk areas around the church. He will be completing the landscaping around the front for the sanctuary.

Buckeye Exterminators will be coming back the 29 of May to finish fogging the crawl space and basement. They have already sprayed around the building. The small roof where the back door to the sanctuary is located is leaking and Dan is getting people lined up to replace the roof. The parish hall roof was inspected and found to be in good shape but needs attention to recaulk the areas where the rubber roof meets the concrete.




