A Little Bit of This and That for February...

During this time, I am teaching a six week workshop on Overcoming Anxiety and Depression that combines scientific knowledge as well as Biblical scripture resources. As I have been putting together the weekly classes, I have become increasingly aware of how important it is to create sacred space to get alone with God.

Jesus often went off by himself to pray. This prayer time was important for refueling him to do the ministry of healing and teaching among his disciples and the many desperate people desiring healing in their lives. What would his ministry have been like if he did not do this? This prayer time kept him connected to the Father, and he often said, "I only do what I see my Father doing." He was all about doing the will of God the Father. His prayer time was critical to his ministry. This is an important lesson on faith for all of us.

As we are called in our vocations to be a light of Christ in our midst, it is important for each of us to get refueled by spending time with Jesus and the Word of God.

Toward the end of February, we will enter the season of Lent and this year I want to encourage all of us to carve out time to sit with scripture and soak in prayer and the presence of God. I recommend the following scriptures to use... **Zephania 3:17, Isaiah 61, John 10:11-15, and Psalms 23, 91, and 139** to ponder and sit with. These are some of my favorite verses because they speak of God's love and care for us. I then recommend that we take the time in Lent to read all the Gospel of John.

In chapter 15 in John, we are admonished to abide in Jesus. He is the vine and we are the branches. We get our nourishment from the vine. Therefore, it is important that we learn to create the time and space to soak in scripture and to ask Jesus to speak to us in his word and through the Holy Spirit.

So, whether you regularly spend non hurried time in prayer and soaking in God's Word, or whether this is something new for you, I invite us all on the journey.

May you be blessed with a deepening knowledge of God's love for you as you soak in God's love and care for you.

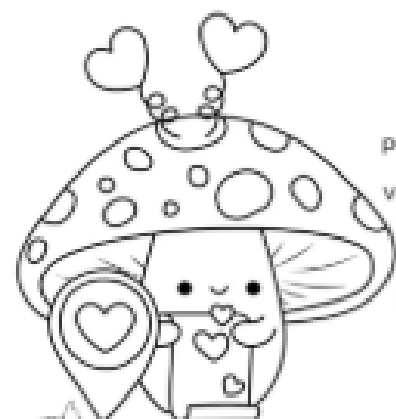
