Last Tuesday my niece, Emily, was able to come to my house for a few hours and I was able to bask in the beauty of the love relationship that she had with her 3-month-old daughter. It was beautiful to watch how Emily attuned to her daughter and to see Millie celebrated. Then at the seminar, I was able to worship freely through song, and I was able to connect with the presence of God in worship. I could raise my hands in praise and just worship our amazing God. I saw beauty in the speakers who shared their wisdom about overcoming anxiety. I saw beauty in the people who greeted me each morning as we entered the venue. Then, Sunday morning, I saw beauty in all of you who were at worship as you worshiped and interacted with me as I preached. You are amazing and beautiful.

So, in this month where we focus on giving thanks, let's focus on things for which to be thankful. Some things might seem ordinary, but they are beautiful...things like filtered water from my sink in my new kitchen or being able to see the sunrise over the lake outside my kitchen window, or being able to connect with a friend. May you find joy in finding beauty.




## Catechism Class Catechism from 1:00-3:00 on November 9th:


