Hence, we encourage all delegations to plan and do a small project then present it during the conference on July 2-8, 2023

## We encourage you to:

- 1. Start from a small scale project
- 2. Attend the conference, present the plan and get your feedback
- 3. Brainstorm and discuss with participants about your project
- 4. Collaborate with another school/country for a sustainable project

If necessary, try to have at least one partnership with organization or community partner located near the project area to simplify the learning process in order to develop a sustainable implementation project in their local community.

Each project must be related to at least one of the following project sub-topics:

- · Coastal Ecosystem
- · Mountain Ecosystem
- · River Ecosystem
- · Urban Ecosystem
- · Rural Ecosystem

## Project Guidelines

## A. Group Project

Each team shall create and provide a solution to an environmental or sustainable issue in their respective countries, which should be related to the conference theme "Natural and Cultural Heritage" and at least one of the sub themes: Coastal ecosystem, Mountain ecosystem. Urban ecosystem and Rural ecosystem.

To help the team prepare for the project, the guideline below will be your reference, we call it FADRI (find-out, analyze, design and decide, implement and reflections).

- 1. FIND OUT (F)
- a. What is the name of the ecosystem that you would like to explore?
- b. Why does the ecosystem special for you?
- c. What kind of environmental problem in that ecosystem?
- d. Choose one sub topic below, that relate to the ecosystem you choose
- · Coastal Ecosystem
- · Mountain Ecosystem
- · River Ecosystem
- · Urban Ecosystem
- · Rural Ecosystem
- 2. ANALYZE (A)
- a. What is the cause of the problem in that ecosystem you have mention on no 1C?
- b. What is the effect of the problem to the environment?
- c. What is the effect of the problems to the society?
- d. What is the effect of the problem to the economic aspect of the society?
- e. What would you like to learn more about?
- f. What kind of support that you need regarding the problem?
- 3. DESIGN AND DECIDE (D)
- a. As young generation with a huge concern to the environment, what will you do to solve the problem?
- b. Name your project; is it an innovation in product or service?
- c. According to your opinion, what is the benefit of your project to the environment, society and economic?













- d. What does the unique and different part from your project (product or service) compare to other project?
- e. Design and describe your idea, for example using design thinking tools, i.e. mindmap fishbone, etc
- f. Identify the potential stakeholder to be your project partner in implementing your plan.
- g. Choose at least one stakeholder to be your main partner;
- h. Provide the list of step activities and timeline that you will take to implement your plan. Your project is expected to be finished in June 2023. However, it can be continued for a long term.
- 4. REALIZE (R)
- a. Do your project and have fun
- b. Don't forget to have your activities recorded (pictures, videos, social media)
- c. You may use learning log below to help you record all activities
- 5. INSPIRE & REFLECTION (I)
- a. Share your project to community; you may use social media, or offline presentation.
- b. What is the most significant/interesting thing that you have learn? why?
- c. What does the good things you do on your project that inspire others?
- d. What is your challenge?
- e. What have you learn that you can use in your everyday life now?
- f. What will you do to improve your project in the future?
- g. Write your Project Summary (200-250 words) and choose 2-3 photos for Homepage.

- h. Publish your project on your social media, mention or tag CEI 2023 Indonesia or in face to face presentation/meeting
- i. Project Presentation: Each delegation or team will have to do a 10-minute project presentation at the conference. (Please practice to meet the required time limit.) We will be asking for these presentations on Google Slides or Microsoft PowerPoint.
