TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Artists are limited to four (4) entries of their choice. Art can be of any depiction, but to be considered for the "theme" awards, the art should incorporate the theme of "The Nine Little Goblins" in some way.
- Entries must be framed with screw eyes and wire only. No saw tooth hangers.
- Artwork will not be displayed or judged due to faulty hanging wire or frames. Please be sure wires are securely attached.
- Registration form must accompany artwork.
- All artwork must have a completed label securely attached to the back of the artwork at time of entry.
- No repeat entries allowed from previous Riley Festival Fine Arts Competitions/Shows.
- No entries may be entered posthumously.
- The Riley Festival reserves the right to disqualify any artwork deemed inappropriate.
- The decision of the Judge will be final.
- Entries exhibited at owner's risk. While the Riley Festival staff will attempt to keep artwork safe and secure after arrival and during the festival, the Riley Festival will not be held responsible for damage, destruction, loss or theft of artwork submitted to the contest.
- The artist or other person picking up artwork must sign for artwork at time of pickup.
- Fine Art entries will be received at the Hancock County Arts Council Gallery, located at 20-A North State St., Greenfield, on Wednesday, October 4th, 2023 from 2:00 pm to 8:00pm.
- Artwork will be released and ready for pick up on Sunday, October 8th, 2022 from 3:30-5:30pm. No early releases.
- Items not picked up will be in the possession of the Riley Festival.

 - Best Illustration of Festival Theme, "The Nine Little Goblins"
 - \$75.00 Cash Award to one entry from an Adult Division (Beg. Adult, Adv. Adult or Prof.)
 - \$50.00 Cash Award to one entry from a Children's Division (Child I, Child II or Interm.)
 - Acton Memorial Award (\$25.00 Cash Award for a portrait in Child I, Child II or Intermediate)
