

## GUIDELINES

1. All nurses (also known as Aids in some churches) must be in good standing, serving in their church.
2. All nurses must complete the Red Cross First Aid and CPR classes and the certificates kept up to date.
3. Have nurses on duty when you have a funeral or programs of the ICUAA. All nurses are to attend memorial services.
4. The attire for all nurses, men or women is all white. No jewelry other than a watch with a sweeping hand, wedding/engagement ring, long or ¾ length sleeved uniform (no short sleeves), white oxford shoes (no open toe or heel), white lab coat to prevent exposure of ladies with dresses on. The pockets on the jacket for pad and pen.  
Red, white, blue emblem (National) on uniform left sleeve (centered about 2 inches below shoulder), white nurses cap. Nurses caps are not to be worn outside the building. No dark undergarments. Nurses must be neat always.
5. When appointed we must be in uniform and give service at the National Convention.  
Manage a first aid station at conventions, conferences and workshops: inspect the site and maintain sanitary conditions around the convention area and **give a report in open session**. The Chairman shall have at least a current certificate from the American Red Cross as a First Aid. The member must have some training & certificate.
6. The Church Nurses are responsible for the Memorial Services at the conventions.
7. The Church Nurses/Aids administer CPR & First Aid only.

## QUESTIONS FOR THE CHURCH NURSES TO ANSWER

1. How many Church Nurses do you have? Are they currently certified?
2. Do the Nurses participate in Memorial Services?
3. Do you have or need the Red, White & Blue emblem? The Red Cross & American Heart Association emblems are not to be worn at the conventions, conferences and workshops.
4. Do you as Chairman or Co-Chairman attend or plan to attend the conventions and workshops?

I pray that the Nurses Guild grow. Encourage each other and the congregation to be aggressive in our faith when it comes to our health and keep asking for the Lord's help when attending to the sick.
