Treasurer continued to prepare checks for Board to review, approve and sign.

Road Engineer and Board discussed the roads that will be repaired this month and before the weather conditions change and projects would not get addressed. There are issues with couple culverts needing to be cleaned out by fire department this will be completed on training night in near future. Resident on Spring Lake Rd also asked if trees and brush could be trimmed back out of road right-away, limbs are hanging over road making it very difficult to see approaching traffic.

Scott Korkowski informed Board that a drying rack for turnout gear was made for department. There are 3 or 4 people interested in joining fire department they will start training as soon as it's available.

Pam and Barb informed Board there were 68 voters for Primary Elections and elections went very well; township has awesome new judges that will be sure the General Elections will be as successful and run smoothly and honestly.

The Cares Act Grant was discussed monies for township for election expense and or added Coronavirus Aid Relief for township. Motion was made and second with Dale Diedrich, Brent Ost and Keith Schultz voting aye for township to:
