LEAF VALLEY TOWNSHIP

CHAIR, Dale Diedrich called the scheduled September 09, 2021 Township meeting to order @ 7:00 pm with Pledge of Allegiance. Supervisors Brent Ost and Keith Schultz, Road Engineer Richard Vogt, Fire Chief Scott Korkowski, Treasurer Barb Guenther, several residents resided on Little Ida Bh. Rd. and Clerk Pam Cuperus were also in attendance.

CLERK read minutes of the August 12, 2021 monthly meeting. Motion was made and second with Dale Diedrich, Brent Ost, and Keith Schultz voting aye to accept minutes as prepared and read, motion carried.

TREASURER gave the prepared financial report for September 01, 2021. General, Road/Bridge and Fire Funds totaled \$716,145.06, Park Fund \$3,460.55, Hall Maintenance Fund \$55,024.53 and First Responder Fund \$4,609.11. Checking account balance was \$2,331.53. In August \$79,000.00 was transferred from checking into savings and income of \$5,755.47 received for the township for the month. Treasurer continued to prepare checks for the Board to approve, review and sign.

At this time several residents living in the Leaf Valley Township residing on Little Ida BH. RD. presented to Board signed petition from many residents requesting Board would/could consider tarring of said road. After a lengthy discussion explaining procedure and policy township follows and answering all questions and concerns Dale will contact Bill Leuthner, township legal adviser, and agreed that hopefully by the October meeting Board will have answers and will be able to inform all residents what next step will need to be taken regarding this project. All would like this project completed in summer of 2022 so getting project moving in right direction now will be very helpful. Information was exchanged so when Board hears anything definite from attorney resident will be contacted.

Board and Road Engineer discussed work that needs to be completed on Ruckheim RD. before weather conditions change. The larger culvert and apron have been ordered so this project can start as soon as culvert is picked up. All other roads in township are in good condition.

Motion was made and second to accept the contract from HiWay Amaco for 2021/2022 for the ball park shed, 500 gallons @ \$1.45: with Dale Diedrich, Brent Ost and Keith Schultz voting aye, motion carried.

Treasurer and Clerk discussed that floors in entire hall need to be professionally cleaned, the Clerk will get all details worked out with whoever is hired.

At this time all building permits were reviewed and discussed. Treasurer had claims #1280 to #1303, voided #1301, prepared for Board to review, approve and sign. General Fund totaled \$3,462.81, Road/Bridge Fund totaled \$2,806.75, Fire Fund totaled \$1,822.14, Park Fund totaled \$898.25, and First Responder Fund totaled \$307.86; all Funds totaled \$9,297.81. Motion was made and second with Dale Diedrich, Brent Ost, and Keith Schultz voting aye to accept and pay all claims, no other discussion motion carried.

There was no other township business needing to be addressed at this time motion was made and second to adjourn with Dale Diedrich, Brent Ost, Keith Schultz voting aye, motion carried. 8:30 pm.
