Chair, Dale Diedrich called to September 11, 2025 scheduled township monthly meeting to order at 7:00pm with the Pledge of Allegiance. Supervisors Brent Ost and Bob Hanson, Treasurer Issy Szech, and Clerk present at meeting. Other guests in attendance were Road Engineer Richard Vogt, Don Kalpin and 1 other Resident.

Minutes: A motion was made and second to accept the Aug 14, 2025 minutes the Dale, Brent, and Bob voting aye, no discussion, motion carried.

Treasurer gave the financial report/statement for Aug 31, 2025. Interest earned at Bremer for month \$911.12, checking account balance \$25,707.34, balance in General, Rd/Bridge and Fire Funds \$582,436.19, FR Fund \$8,489.36, Park Fund \$5,597.21, Hall Maint \$29,642.66 and FR Trk Fund \$25,000.00. Treasurer transferred \$40,000 from savings to checking account. There was income into township totaling \$868.56. Motion was made and second to accept this report as prepared and read with Dale, Brent and Bob voting aye, motion carried. Treasure continued to prepare checks for Board.

Visitor from Little Ida Beach Rd present to question what happened to the drainage pond on Little Ida Beach Rd. Dale stated the county approved to have the pond drained and filled in. It was out of the townships jurisdiction.

Road Engineer Richard Vogt present from RBS. Richard stated they are still unable to check condition of culvert on Dove Ln due to water levels. They will continue to monitor culvert and keep supervisors informed as soon as they are able to assess condition. Supervisors and RBS stated they still have yet to get an update on when culvert on Dittberners Crk Rd replacement project is to take place.

Don Kalpin present for Fire Department. Don stated the Fire Dept would like to purchase a gas detector for the fire dept. Fire department presented information on gas detector they are hoping to purchase with the township supervisor's approval along with the estimate cost. Board approved purchase of gas detector for the fire department. Don stated all trucks have been running good with no issues.

Nobody presents for the First Responders. Dale stated at this time the Board is going to encourage First Responders to seek out donations from local organizations to help raise funds for the First Responders Truck Fund.

No old business to follow up on at this time.

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No new business to address at this time.

At this time Board reviewed Licensing, Building permits and all other township correspondence.

There was no other township business needing to be addressed motion was made and second to adjourn with Dale, Brent and Bob voting aye, motion carried. 7:41pm
