It is a strange time we live in. Over the last few months, the pandemic has affected everyone. It has taken time for us to develop any real understanding of what to do about the House as it relates to visitation and residency. Although nothing can be 100% effective., there are some rules that have been put in place to help in the health and safety of our Brothers as it relates to the House. We have put into place safety measures that relate to house visitation and residency. Please follow the rules whenever you visit the House. Wear a face covering when entering the property, use hand sanitizer or wash your hands with the recommended method, follow social distancing guidelines, limit your exposure to the common area touch surfaces, and follow other safety measures. We want to limit the risk to our Brothers, Alumni, family, and friends.

Safety measures have been put in place for everyone to follow. It will be an interesting semester with limited activity and minimal outside visitation at the House. This is going to be the biggest challenge since this is a social fraternity and contact with our Brothers is the part of our daily life. The virtual meeting places and electronic communication will be tested over the coming months.

The number of residents is limited this semester with single rooms being utilized to encourage social distancing and limit contact risk. The guys in the House either have local jobs that are needed to pay for their education or Internships.

Keep Healthy- Follow all the guidelines from the CDC, State, County and United Health Organizations Here are some rules from the United Health Organizations: Hands- Wash your hands often Elbow- Cough into your elbow or disposable tissue and if you feel sick stay home Face- Do not touch Stay six feet apart There has been constant contact with the Current Sage Jared, Health and Safety Committee and Housing Association. The Health and Safety Committee published an encompassing list of safety measures to all the undergraduate Chapter members to follow to combat this pandemic and still have access to the House. Here is a quick outline:

- The barriers were installed to encourage social distancing. in both the Mantel room and the Meeting room
- Installation of a non-contact hand sanitizer
- Daily Temperatures are taken and privately recorded
- Negative COVID Testing for residents before moving in
- Masks are required at all times when using the indoor and outdoor common areas
- The Sage created a Health and Safety Committee to monitor daily and weekly health checks
- Updated some deadbolts and door codes
- Follow social distancing and CDC guidelines at all times (No Tolerance Policy)
- Limited guest policy
- Additional rules & other safety measures
- No social events

Here are some measures that have been put in place: daily resident monitoring of health by the Health & Safety committee chaired by the current Sage, temperature readings privately recording with daily testing and reporting for residents, negative COVID-19 test requirements, non-contact hand sanitizer or wash hands as you enter the kitchen area foyer, daily cleaning routines, installed barriers outside the Mantel room and in the Meeting room to limit common touch areas and encourage social distancing with signage throughout the common areas.
