Repairs & Safety items -2020

Roof repairs, drywall repair due to roof leak, replaced Humidifier pump in basement, sewer drainage cleaning, replaced boards on front porch and porch steps, Installed additional Railings in basement and outside steps for an insurance requirement. Contracted Terminix for quarterly treatment and we have a service contract with local Heating and Plumbing company for the Hot Water Heater and Boiler. Installation of COVID area Barriers for social distancing, floor and wall signage for social distancing, purchased a touchless thermometer, and Hand sanitizer dispenser and supplies. There was no damage assessment to the Residents security deposits last semester. They took good care of the common areas. The residents have really taken ownership of our house. They did some painting and have taken part in all the work parties following social distancing and face covering requirements.

The Safety measures we adopted have limited the exposure to the Brothers, Alumni, Friends, and family. This was an interesting semester with limited activity and minimal outside visitation at the House. This was the biggest challenge since this is a social fraternity and contact with our Brothers is the part of our daily life. The virtual meetings and electronic communication media have been a huge part of the Brother's interaction
