#### Important aspect of Fraternal life- Provided by Sigma Pi National

**Fraternity members graduate at higher rates than their peers.** And, while two-thirds of college students aren't optimistic they'll get a job that fits their career goals post-graduation, fraternity members can tap built-in alumni networks, finding jobs more quickly than their unaffiliated peers.

As you may have seen in the news recently, college-aged students are experiencing loneliness and depression at increasing rates. And the unfortunate reality is that young men in particular often feel lost (<u>The Wall Street Journal</u>). And even as mental health conversations continue to make their way to the forefront of college preparedness (<u>The New York Times</u>), students continue to need in-person or telehealth support at their institution. Yet, on many campuses, counseling centers are overwhelmed and struggling to keep up with the clear need (<u>The Hechinger Report</u>)

Recent <u>research</u> on fraternities shows members experience stronger mental health and wellness than their un affiliated peers. In fact, fraternities empower men to create healthy support systems.

According to research, these support systems can create a strong sense of belonging, leading to more positive mental health and less anxiety and depression than other students. *In fact, nearly 80% of fraternity men reported having excellent to good mental health and wellbeing.* 

Fraternity brothers feel comfortable having tough conversations and learn from each other, and when seeking help, research shows members are twice as likely to reach out to a fraternity brother than anyone else.
