**Happy Mother's Day!** As we celebrate Mother's Day, we send our warmest wishes to all the mothers in our community. We pray for your continued health, peace, and many abundant blessings. We will honor all living mothers during the Divine Liturgy at 9:30 AM today, followed by a Panachida service for those who have passed away.
