**Troparion of the Departed - Tone 8**

In the depth of your wis-dom, O on - ly Cre - a - tor, you gov - ern  
all with love and sup - ply the needs of each. Now give rest to  
the souls of your ser - vants, for they have placed their hope in you,  
our Cre - a - tor, Mak - er, and our God.

Glo - ry to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Ho - ly Spir - it.

**Kontakion of the Departed - Tone 8**

With the saints, O Christ, give rest to your ser - vants, where there is  
no pain, sor - row, nor mourn - ning, but life ev - er - last - ing.

Now and ev - er and for - ev - - er.

**Theotokion - Tone 8 troparion**

We have in you a de-fense and a ref - uge, and an ad - vo - cate  
ac - cept - a - ble to God, to whom you gave birth, O Vir - gin

**Prokeimenon of the Faithful Departed - Tone 6 (Psalm 24: 13, 1)**

Their souls will dwell, their souls will dwell a - mong the good.

**Verse:** To you, O Lord, I lift up my soul.

**Alleluia of the Faithful Departed - Tone 6 (Psalm 64:5; Sirach 39:9):**

Note that on the Fifth All Souls Saturday (the Saturday before the feast of Pentecost), we do not sing “We have seen the true light” after Holy Communion; in its place, the troparion for the departed, “In the depths of your wisdom...” is sung (see the first page of this leaflet).

### Intonation for the Deceased:

**Celebrant:** In blessed repose, grant, O Lord, eternal rest to your departed servants (*Names*) and remember them forever.
