**Liturgical Schedule July and August 2022**. Because the Father and Cantor John will be away during summer, as well as because of the Vietnamese picnic, the liturgical schedule will be somewhat different in July/August. Please find in the vestibule the printed schedule with the liturgies and take it home so it is easier to know when and at what time the services are celebrated.

**Friday/Thursday Divine Liturgy**. After having heard from several parishioners who attend the Divine Liturgy on Fridays, it seems that the schedule at 11am works better. Because of Father's teaching assignment (one semester on Thursdays and another on Fridays), the schedule that works better seems to be as follow: first half of the year, January through June, the Divine Liturgy will be on Thursdays at 11am; the second half of the year, from July through December, the liturgy will be celebrated on Fridays at 11am. The Feast Days liturgy falling on the week days or Presanctified Gifts will replace this liturgy whenever they are celebrated.
