Palm Sunday 2023. Please mark your calendars: April 2 will be a special Palm Sunday at St Johns: Easter Egg Hunt will be organized for the children and we will also be smoking kolbasy. Each household will receive one kolbasa, and we kindly ask you to give a suggested donation of \$5.00 that will help to cover the cost of wood and meat. It is not a fundraiser: it aims at creating one more social moment for the parish. Approximately 40/50 kolbasy will be smoked: the first round of 20/25 during the liturgy, and the second after the liturgy. It only takes about 60/80 minutes to smoke. A light social will be served while waiting for kolbasy.
