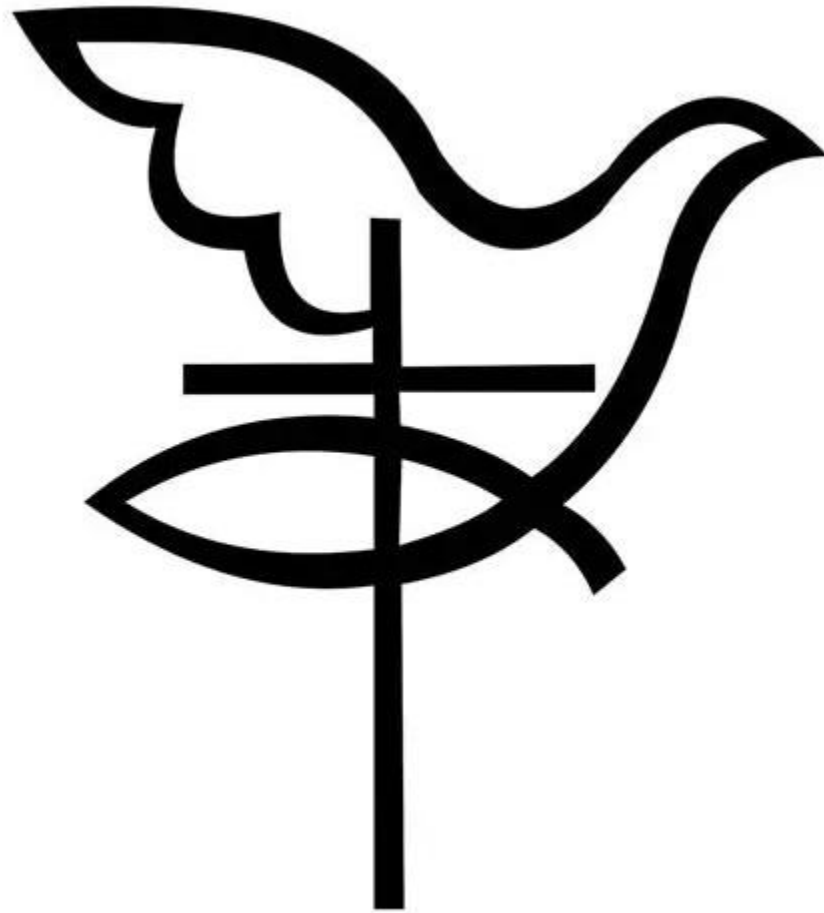


HOPE FOR THE LEFT BEHIND

A Letter to Those Who Remain After the Rapture



“But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.”

— Matthew 24:13

 If you are reading this, then something has happened that the world cannot fully explain.

Millions of people may have vanished suddenly. Families have been separated. Children may be missing. Cars may have crashed. Airplanes may have fallen. Entire cities may be in confusion. Governments, scientists, media outlets, and world leaders may already be trying to calm the world with explanations.

They may say it was aliens.

They may say it was a cosmic event.

They may claim it was an evolutionary shift.

They may invent scientific theories.

But the truth is this:

Jesus Christ came for those who belonged to Him.

What you are witnessing is what the Bible calls the Rapture.

Those who trusted in Jesus Christ were taken from the earth before a coming time of worldwide judgment known in Scripture as the Tribulation.

If you were left behind, this letter is not written to condemn you.

It is written to give you hope.

The Bible teaches that salvation is not based on being “good enough,” religious, or moral. Many people knew about Jesus but never truly placed their trust in Him. Others rejected Him, ignored Him, or delayed turning to Him. But if you are still alive, God’s mercy is still available to you. That means you still have a choice.

God has not abandoned you. Even now, in the middle of fear, confusion, and chaos, He is extending mercy.

DO NOT BELIEVE THE LIES

Very quickly, the world system will try to control the narrative.

You will hear explanations from governments, celebrities, influencers, scientists, religious leaders, and media organizations. Most of them will deny Jesus Christ and mock the Bible.

But the Bible warned humanity about these events thousands of years ago.

The disappearance of believers was not caused by aliens.

It was not caused by technology.

It was not caused by another dimension.

It was the fulfillment of biblical prophecy.

The Bible says:

“For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air.”

— 1 Thessalonians 4:16–17

The phrase “caught up” is where the term “Rapture” comes from.

You are now living in the beginning of what Scripture warned about.

WHAT MAY HAPPEN NEXT

The world is about to change rapidly.

At first there may be calls for unity, peace, rebuilding, and global cooperation. A powerful world leader may rise and appear to have all the answers.

The Bible calls him the Antichrist.

He may appear intelligent, compassionate, charismatic, peaceful, and convincing. He may promise stability during worldwide collapse.

But he will deceive many.

The Bible warns that he will eventually demand worship and total allegiance.

There will come a time when people will be pressured to receive a mark connected to buying and selling.

The warning is simple:

DO NOT TAKE THE MARK!

No matter the pressure.

No matter the hunger.

No matter the fear.

No matter the threats.

Do not worship the Antichrist.

Do not give him your loyalty.

Do not take his mark.

THERE IS STILL HOPE FOR YOU

Please understand this clearly:

You have not committed an unforgivable sin by being left behind.

Many people will still come to faith in Jesus Christ during the Tribulation.

The Bible describes a countless multitude from every nation turning to God during this period.

But following Jesus after the Rapture may cost you everything.

You may lose relationships.

You may lose your job.

You may be rejected.

You may suffer persecution.

You may even be killed for refusing to deny Christ.

But eternal life is real – Jesus conquered death – Heaven is real – And Jesus is still saving people.

WHO JESUS REALLY IS

Jesus was not merely a prophet.

He was not just a good teacher.

He was not one spiritual option among many.

Jesus Christ is the Son of God.

Every human being has sinned – Sin separates humanity from God.

No amount of good works, religion, kindness, or morality can erase sin.

That is why Jesus came.

Jesus lived a sinless life.

He willingly died on the cross for the sins of the world.

He took the punishment humanity deserved.

Then He rose from the dead three days later.

His resurrection proved that He truly is Lord – Salvation has always been through faith in Jesus Christ.

Jesus said:

“I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.”

— John 14:6

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO NOW

1. TURN TO JESUS CHRIST

Speak honestly to God – You do not need religious rituals or perfect words

You need genuine repentance and faith – Admit your sin

Believe that Jesus died for your sins and rose again – Ask Him to forgive you and save you!

The Bible says:

“Whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.”

— Romans 10:13

2. READ THE BIBLE

The Bible will become your source of truth in a world filled with deception. Start with:

- The Gospel of John
- Matthew
- Romans
- Revelation
- Daniel
- Psalms

Pay attention to prophecies being fulfilled around you.

3. PRAY CONSTANTLY

Speak to God daily. Ask for wisdom. Ask for courage. Ask for discernment. Ask for strength.

4. FIND OTHER TRUE BELIEVERS CAREFULLY

There will still be genuine followers of Christ during this time. But deception will increase greatly.

Not everyone claiming to represent Christianity will truly follow Jesus Christ. Some religious systems may compromise truth for safety, unity, or political power. Use Scripture as your foundation.

5. REFUSE THE MARK

This cannot be repeated enough: DO NOT TAKE THE MARK OF THE BEAST.

Even if society pressures you.

Even if food becomes scarce.

Even if survival becomes difficult.

Trust God above the system.

WHAT THE WORLD MAY BECOME

The Bible describes wars, famine, economic collapse, disease, persecution, natural disasters, and terrifying judgments.

You may witness:

- Massive government control
- Digital surveillance
- Food shortages
- Worldwide instability
- Religious persecution
- False miracles and deception
- Hatred toward true Christians

Fear will spread across the earth.

But remember this:

God is still sovereign.

Nothing happening is outside His knowledge.

IF YOU FEEL REGRET

You may be thinking:

“Why didn’t I listen?”

“Why didn’t I take this seriously?”

“I heard about Jesus before.”

Do not stay trapped in despair. The enemy wants you hopeless.

But as long as you are alive, you can still turn to Christ.

The fact that you are reading this means there is still opportunity.

Do not waste it.

You can still be forgiven!

No matter how far you ran from God before this moment, Jesus Christ is still willing to forgive those who sincerely turn to Him.

IF CHRISTIANS YOU KNEW DISAPPEARED

Think about the people who tried to warn you.

Maybe:

- A parent
- A friend
- A coworker
- A grandparent
- A pastor
- Someone online

Maybe they talked about Jesus.

Maybe they spoke about repentance.

Maybe they warned about the Rapture.

Now they are gone.

Their disappearance was not random.

Let it awaken you to the truth.

TO THOSE WHO ARE TERRIFIED

You may feel overwhelmed.

You may be grieving missing loved ones.

You may feel abandoned or confused.

God understands your fear.

Run to Him.

Jesus Christ is still the only true source of peace. Even in suffering, He can give supernatural strength and hope.

REMEMBER THIS ABOVE ALL

God loved humanity enough to send His Son. Jesus Christ willingly died so sinners could be forgiven.

Even now, after everything that has happened, God is still calling people to Himself.

Do not believe the lie that it is too late.

If you sincerely turn to Jesus Christ, He will receive you.

A SIMPLE PRAYER

If you desire to turn to Jesus Christ, you can pray something like this:

“Jesus, I understand now that Your Word was true. I confess that I am a sinner and that I need Your forgiveness. I believe You died on the cross for my sins and rose again. Please save me, forgive me, and help me remain faithful no matter what comes. Give me courage, wisdom, and strength to follow You. I place my trust in You alone. Amen.”

The prayer itself does not save you.
Jesus saves.

But if these words truly reflect your heart, call upon Him.

IMPORTANT!

The world may become darker than anything humanity has ever experienced.

But darkness does not overcome truth.

Jesus Christ is real.
The Bible is true.
And hope still exists for those willing to turn to Him.

Do not surrender to deception.
Do not worship the Antichrist.
Do not take the mark.

Stand firm.
Seek God.
Hold onto the truth.

And remember:

Even in the darkest hour, Jesus Christ is still the Savior.

“And ye shall seek me, and find me, when ye shall search for me with all your heart.”
— Jeremiah 29:13

WHAT WILL HAPPEN DURING THE 7-YEAR TRIBULATION

If you are reading this after the Rapture, then the world has already entered the beginning of the period the Bible warned about thousands of years ago.

The books of Book of Daniel and Book of Revelation describe what humanity is about to experience.

These next seven years will be unlike anything the world has ever seen.

This is not science fiction.

This is not mythology.

This is a biblical prophecy unfolding before your eyes.

According to Bible prophecy, the Rapture starts a final seven-year period often called “the Tribulation.” This understanding mainly comes from the Book of Daniel and the Book of Revelation, along with passages in The Gospel of Matthew, 2 Thessalonians, and elsewhere.

The “seven years” idea is commonly connected to Daniel’s prophecy of the “seventy weeks” in Daniel 9.

THE WORLD WILL DEMAND ANSWERS

After the disappearances, the world will be desperate for stability.

Governments will seek control.

Economies may collapse.

Violence and fear may spread rapidly.

People everywhere will search for someone to restore order.

Out of this chaos, a powerful world leader will rise. At first, he may appear to be the answer humanity has been waiting for.

He may seem:

- Peaceful
- Charismatic
- Wise
- Intelligent
- Compassionate
- Diplomatic

He may unite nations. He may bring temporary peace. He may offer solutions to global crisis.

But the Bible warns that this man is the Antichrist. He will deceive the world.

THE FOUNDATION IN DANIEL

Daniel speaks of seventy “weeks” (often understood as seventy sets of seven years) determined for Israel and Jerusalem. A central verse is: $70 \times 7 = 490$

Many interpreters believe:

- 69 weeks were fulfilled leading up to the coming of Jesus.
- One final “week” of 7 years remains in the future.

Daniel 9:27 says a coming ruler will confirm a covenant for one “week,” but halfway through it he breaks it and brings desolation. That midpoint becomes very important in Revelation.

OVERVIEW OF THE 7 YEARS

The seven years are commonly divided into two halves: 7 years = 3.5 + 3.5: The second half is often called:

- “The Great Tribulation”
- “Jacob’s Trouble”
- A time of unprecedented judgment

Jesus referenced this in Matthew 24.

BEGINNING OF THE 7 YEARS

After global chaos and instability, a powerful leader emerges → Rise of a world leader (Antichrist)

The Bible describes him as:

He is commonly called:

He likely appears at first as a peacemaker.

Daniel 9:27 speaks of a covenant being confirmed for seven years, often interpreted as involving Israel and peace in the Middle East.

THE FIRST 3.5 YEARS

The first part of these seven years may begin with promises of peace and security.

But underneath the surface, the world will continue moving toward darkness. The Bible describes:

- Wars
- Economic collapse
- Food shortages
- Disease
- Natural disasters
- Fear spreading across nations

Revelation describes judgments being poured out upon the earth one after another.

Humanity will become increasingly desperate. Yet many people will still refuse to turn to God.

3.5 years = 42 months = 1260 days. These equivalent time expressions appear repeatedly in Revelation and Daniel. During this period, many believe:

- Global government structures strengthen
 - Economic control systems expand
 - Religious unity movements increase
 - Wars, famine, disasters, and instability intensify

THE TWO WITNESSES

Revelation 11 describes two prophetic witnesses in Jerusalem. →1260 days

They preach, perform miracles, and confront evil during part of the Tribulation.

Eventually they are killed, but later resurrected publicly.

THE SEAL JUDGMENTS (REVELATION 6)

Jesus, symbolized as the Lamb, opens seven seals.

- First Seal — White Horse: A conqueror emerges, often linked to the Antichrist's rise.
- Second Seal — Red Horse: War and violence spread across earth.
- Third Seal — Black Horse: Economic collapse and famine.
- Fourth Seal — Pale Horse: Death through war, hunger, disease, and chaos.
- Fifth Seal: Martyrs cry out for justice.
- Sixth Seal: Massive cosmic disturbances and worldwide fear. People realize divine judgment is unfolding.

THE 144,000

Revelation 7 describes 144,000 sealed servants from the tribes of Israel.

Many interpret them as Jewish evangelists proclaiming God during the Tribulation.

At the same time, Revelation describes a vast multitude from every nation coming to faith in Christ.

THE MIDPOINT — AFTER 3.5 YEARS

Halfway through the seven years, everything changes.

The Antichrist will no longer pretend to be a man of peace. He will reveal his true nature.

He will exalt himself above God.

He will demand worship.

He will persecute anyone who refuses to follow him.

Jesus warned this would become the greatest time of suffering the world has ever known.

This period is often called:
THE GREAT TRIBULATION.

This is the major turning point.

The Antichrist breaks the covenant.

Daniel calls this:

- “The abomination of desolation”

Jesus specifically warned about this in Matthew 24.

Many believe the Antichrist enters a rebuilt temple and declares himself to be God.

This begins the most severe period of the Tribulation.

THE FALSE PROPHET

Revelation describes a second figure called the False Prophet.

He supports the Beast and performs deceptive signs and wonders.

He encourages the world to worship the Beast.

THE MARK OF THE BEAST

During this time, a global system will emerge connected to buying and selling.

One of the most well-known prophecies appears in Revelation 13. People are pressured to receive a mark connected to commerce:

No one may buy or sell without it.

Many Christians interpret this as a future global economic identification system tied to worship and loyalty.

The Bible says people will be pressured to receive a mark tied to allegiance to the Beast.

Listen carefully:

DO NOT TAKE THE MARK!

No matter the pressure - No matter the fear - No matter the hunger - No matter the threats.

Do not take it!

The Bible warns that this mark represents loyalty to a system that stands against God.

Many people will comply because they are afraid.

Others will comply because they trust the Antichrist.

Do not follow them!

Stay faithful to Jesus Christ!

THE GREAT TRIBULATION (LAST 3.5 YEARS)

The final half becomes far more intense.

Jesus said:

“For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world...”

During this time:

- Persecution becomes extreme
- Believers are hunted
- Deception increases dramatically
- Judgments intensify
- The Beast demands worship

BELIEVERS WILL BE PERSECUTED

Those who refuse the Beast system may become targets.

Many believers will:

- Be rejected
- Hunted
- Imprisoned
- Killed

Following Jesus during this time may cost you everything.

But remember this:

The Antichrist's power is temporary. Jesus Christ is eternal.

Even death is not the end for those who belong to Christ.

GOD WILL STILL CALL PEOPLE TO REPENTANCE

Even during judgment, God will continue reaching out to humanity.

Revelation describes:

- Witnesses proclaiming truth
- People turning to Christ
- Warnings being given to the earth

God's mercy will still be available. If you are reading this, there is still hope for you.

Turn fully to Jesus Christ.

THE TRUMPET JUDGMENTS

Seven trumpets bring escalating catastrophes:

The judgments intensify progressively.

THE BOWL JUDGMENTS

The final judgments are poured out rapidly:

- Painful sores
- Seas turned to blood
- Rivers affected
- Scorching heat
- Darkness
- Global upheaval

Human rebellion against God intensifies even during judgment.

BABYLON THE GREAT

Revelation describes a powerful end-times world system called “Babylon.”

Interpretations vary:

- Some see it as a literal city
- Others as a global economic/religious system
- Others as symbolic of worldwide corruption and rebellion against God

Eventually it collapses dramatically.

THE SECOND COMING OF CHRIST

At the end of the 7 year Tribulation, Jesus Christ returns visibly and powerfully.

Unlike the Rapture, this is not a secret or sudden disappearance. The nations of the earth will witness His coming.

The Bible describes:

- Christ returning with power and glory
- The defeat of the Beast and False Prophet
- Deliverance for believers
- Judgment upon evil

Revelation 19 describes Christ returning on a white horse as King of Kings.

Jesus Christ will establish His kingdom.

ARMAGEDDON

Toward the end of the seven years, the nations of the earth gather for a final rebellion against God. This conflict is associated with Armageddon.

The armies of the world will unite against Jerusalem and against the authority of Jesus Christ.

But this battle is not ultimately between nations. It is humanity's final rebellion against God Himself.

Jesus Christ returns in power and glory and defeats the armies of the Beast.

Evil does not win - Christ wins!

SATAN BOUND

Revelation 20 describes Satan being bound for 1,000 years.

The one who deceived the nations, inspired the Beast, and opposed God throughout history is finally restrained.

Satan's power over the earth comes to an end - The deception that dominated the Tribulation is removed.

For the first time in human history, the world experiences the righteous rule of Jesus Christ.

This begins what many call The Millennial Kingdom (Christ's thousand-year reign).

THERE IS AN END TO THE TRIBULATION

The suffering of these years will not continue forever.

God has appointed an end to evil - The judgments will end - The Beast will be defeated.

Satan will be bound - Jesus Christ will reign.

If you belong to Christ, hold firmly to your faith.

Your hope is not in surviving the Tribulation,

Your hope is in Jesus Christ!

FINAL WARNING

The days ahead will be terrifying.

Deception will increase.

Fear will increase.

Pressure will increase.

But do not surrender your soul to the Beast system.

Do not worship the Antichrist.

Do not deny Jesus Christ.

Do not take the mark.

Stand firm.

Read the Bible.

Regardless of interpretation, the central biblical message remains:

- Jesus Christ is Lord
- God is sovereign over history
- Evil will not ultimately win
- Salvation is found through Christ
- Believers are called to faithfulness and readiness

Pray constantly - Seek God with all your heart.

The world may grow darker than you ever imagined.

But even then, Jesus Christ is still the Savior.
