General Information

A. Purpose

This Request for Proposal (RFP) is to contract for the demolition of property owned by Kentucky Mountain Health Alliance, Inc., located at 233 E. Main Street, Hazard, KY 41701, formerly owned by Martha Greer Realty.

B. Who May Respond

Only licensed and insured companies ("Bidder") may respond to this RFP.

C. Instructions on Proposal Submission

- 1. <u>Closing Submission Date</u>: Proposals must be submitted no later than 2PM on September 12, 2025.

- 3. <u>Condition of Proposal</u>: All costs incurred in the preparation of a proposal responding to this RFP will be the responsibility of the Bidder and will not be reimbursed by Kentucky Mountain Health Alliance, Inc. (KMHA)

Failure to do so may result in premature disqualification of your proposal.

It is the responsibility of the Bidder to ensure that the proposal is received by Kentucky Mountain Health Alliance, Inc. by the date and time specified above. Late proposals will not be considered.

5. <u>Right to Reject</u>: KENTUCKY MOUNTAIN HEALTH ALLIANCE, INC., reservices the right to reject any and all proposals received in response to this RFP. A contract for the accepted proposal will be based on the factors described in this RFP. KMHA may cancel an (Information for Bidders (IFB) or reject all bids if it is determined that such decision is in the best interest of KMHA. Bidders will be notified in writing of such cancellation or

rejection. KMHA may allow a vendor to withdraw their bid if requested at any time prior to the bid opening. Late bids will not be accepted.

D. Pre-Bid Meeting

A Non-Mandatory Pre-Bid meeting shall be held at the <u>job-site</u> on Tuesday, September 2, 2025 at two o'clock (2:00 p.m.) EST, located at 233 E. Main Street, Hazard, KY 41701.

E. Scope of Project

The project consists of the demolition and removal of all debris – cost of all permits, destruction and removal of debris should be included in your bid:

1. Preparation and Planning:

Site Assessment: Before demolition, the building's structure and materials should be assessed to determine the best approach and identify potential hazards.

Permits and Safety: Demolition requires permits and adherence to safety regulations to protect workers and the surrounding environment.

2. Demolition Process:

Manual or Mechanical: Demolition can be done manually with tools like sledgehammers, or mechanically using heavy equipment like excavators, cranes, or wrecking balls.

3. Debris Management:

Demolition debris should be properly disposed of in the landfill.

Salvaging and Recycling: Materials with salvage value, like steel, copper, aluminum, and some types of wood, will be given to the approved bidder to be taken to scrap yards or recycled for reuse, if they so choose.

4. Site Preparation for Future Use:

Clearing and Grading: After demolition and debris removal, the site is to be cleared of remaining debris and graded to ensure proper drainage.

F. Duration of Project

This project must be completed within two (2) months from acceptance of bid. Estimated date of deliverables being November 15, 2025.
