## Conditions of Licensing:

In order for your Colt/Stallions progeny to be considered for registration by the CBHSA, he must hold an Australasian Permit to Breed Sporthorses (or Prior to 1<sup>st</sup> August 2000 a CBHSA License) with the CBHSA for the stud season in which they are sired. The stud season runs from 1<sup>st</sup> August to 31<sup>st</sup> July each year and an annual instalment (payed over 4 years – total of \$200) fee of \$\$50 is payable prior to the commencement of each season or a once only lifetime fee of \$150.

All Colts and Stallions currently registered with the CBHSA which have at least 50% Cleveland Bay blood are eligible to be nominated for an Australasian Permit to Breed Sporthorses from the CBHSA.
