GLEN LAKE WATERSHED MANAGEMENT PLAN - MEMBERSHIP - All of the residents of the Glen Lake Tax District should have received a Septic Survey to complete and return to our watershed management plan consultant - LaBella Associates. We have already received 65 responses. Thank you. Please complete the survey and return it. We had previously asked that it be returned by a certain time but we are extending that time period to get as many surveys completed and returned as possible. This is an informational not a regulatory survey that will help us complete our Glen Lake Watershed Management Plan. Remember that two lucky survey responders will each win a gift certificate to the Docksider Restaurant Please help us and help the lake by returning a completed survey.

MANAGEMENT of INVASIVE AQUATICS 2022 - Because we were unable to manage the lake last summer, we observed a significant increase in aquatic vegetation. As a result we will be slightly increasing the number of acres treated this season to a maximum of 34. On or around June 9, Aquathal Super K will be applied to control the spread of Eurasian Milfoil, Curlyleaf Pondweed and Brittle Naiad. We will also be doing four weeks of diver assisted hand harvesting to clean up any remaining areas. If you have any questions please contact - Paul Derby at 518-761-7015. These dates can also be found on our website. A zoom option will be offered and a link will be emailed to each member before the meeting. Boating Safety - Anytime a boat is pulling a skier, boarder, barefooter etc. there needs to be an observer. Personal Watercraft are not exempt from requiring an observer as well as a driver. If 2 you are trying to drive and observe you are doing a disservice to the safety of other boaters and you tow. Thank you.

CONSTITUTION AND BYLAW CHANGES: Membership will vote on **4 proposed changes** at June meeting. Board agreed we will recommend voting Yes on proposals 2-4 and No on proposal 1. Proposals 2-4 add privacy language, make minor changes to dam and environmental committees, and add livestreaming to meetings when practical. Proposal 1 changes voting to up to 4 votes per property. If that is voted down, we will then propose each tax unit gets 2 full membership votes and open it for discussion. If you own 2 tax district properties, you can buy memberships and voting rights for both properties. If you are a single owner, you can buy a second membership if you want the second vote.
