SAFE BOATING - The number of boats and activity has been unusually high and so it is particularly important to practice safe boating.

Boats towing anyone need an observer.

Boats going more than 5 mph should be no closer than 100 ft. from shore.

ROAD IMPROVEMENTS - The County will be improving Oxbow Rd. to Moon Hill Rd. and Moon Hill all the way to Bay Rd. The county will be working to improve the surface and improve the drainage from the road. Since this road runs along the outlet of Glen Lake we think this should be a good thing.
