This is a perfectly kept scorecard recorded by Team Woods/Mickelson.

Player hole scores are to entered as gross score only (not net and do not write gross & net scores down together i.e. 5/4).

Please remember there are two different score keeping lines and note the following:

Scoring line A - write down what happened to your team only. You can either gain 1 or 2, lose 1 or 2 or push on each hole.

Scoring line B - this should reflect where the match stands after any particular hole is completed.

Knowing where you match stands is very important, especially in the latter stages so you know whether you need to play conservative or go for hero shots to make ground up!

Please total the players scores. If the match ends early circle the winning match total then take par plus your regular handicap for the remaining individual hole scores. You also have the option to play out the rest of the holes and complete your round.

The example match was very close as you can see. It was closed on the 17th hole. The players did not play the 18th hole so they all take bogeys due to the fact they all would normally get a 5 based on the current handicaps.
