## Our Health Guarantee

All Four Gables Doodles are our personal dogs. They are raised with us in our homes in Roswell and at Lake Oconee. They live in the house with us and are with us at all times. All of our breeding dogs have been tested and certified according to the recommendations by the AKC Poodle Club of America, GANA (Goldendoodles of North America), and the AKC Golden Retriever Club of America. At Four Gables Doodles, we will not breed any dog that is affected by any of the diseases that their breed is tested for. This warrants our puppies to be free from any of the genetic diseases that the Dam and Sire have been tested for. Our sire and dam have been tested through Embark Veterinary and Paw Print Genetics. All Four Gables' Doodles puppies come with a <a href="two-year">two-year</a> health guarantee.

While our puppies are in our care, we feed them well and give them the best care possible to grow into strong and healthy pets for years to come. They are hand-raised in our home. Each puppy is checked by our licensed veterinarian, who determines that the puppies are ready to go live with their new owners. Shot and Deworming records are given to our buyers at the time of pick-up.

## General Health Guarantee

Your puppy will leave Four Gables Doodles having received a puppy well-check visit with our veterinarian, Tritt Animal Hospital and will have received three wormings, and their first inoculation for Distemper and Parvovirus. You have a **72-hour** general health guarantee. I recommend that you set up an appointment to have your new puppy evaluated, but you <u>must</u> make an appointment for their <u>next set of inoculations</u>. Four Gables Doodles is not responsible for any vet bill.

Intestinal parasites (worms) are common in puppies, and even though the puppies have been treated by our vet, I recommend a re-examination until your puppy is free of parasites. KEEP YOUR PUPPY AWAY FROM OTHER DOGS AND PUBLIC AREAS UNTIL THEY ARE FULLY VACCINATED. Parvovirus is easily transmitted and deadly to young puppies.

There will be no return on any puppy unless you have met the above criteria. If your puppy does become seriously ill within this time, please go to the vet (or a local emergency vet if after hours) and get a letter of diagnosis to be given to me upon the return of your puppy.

# Long-term Health Guarantee

Four Gables Puppies come with a guarantee that covers his/her hips and eyes until 24 months of age. If your puppy is diagnosed as having any diagnosed genetic disease, Four Gables Doodles will reimburse the owner for vet fees incurred up to the price paid for the puppy. Four Gables Puppies come with a guarantee that covers his/her hips and eyes until 24 months of age. If your puppy is diagnosed as having any diagnosed genetic disease, Four Gables Doodles will reimburse the owner for vet fees incurred up to the price paid for the puppy. The second option is to return the puppy, at your expense, to us if you don't want the puppy/dog for a full refund or a replacement puppy when one becomes available. PLEASE NOTE! You do not have to return the original puppy to Four Gables Doodles. That decision is yours to make.

This guarantee only applies to the original purchase of the puppy. The long-term health guarantee is **voided if** the condition was caused by injuries acquired through training, play, or other activities (running) deemed inappropriate for developing joints.

The long-term health guarantee is <u>voided</u> <u>if</u> the injury was caused due to neglect, malnourishment, or obesity.

To qualify for a refund, your puppy's X-rays must be confirmed by a licensed veterinarian who will send a statement to me along with a copy of the X-rays for my vet's review.

#### **NEW PUPPY REQUIREMENTS**

- Keep your puppy up to date on shots, worming and other preventative protocol. Follow the guidelines on annual vaccinations to keep the health guarantee. They are specific and will be provided at pick-up.
- Feed your puppy a good, well-rounded age appropriate diet. Do not underfeed or overfeed your puppy. In general, follow the recommended feeding guidelines found on the bag.

- Find top-rated pet foods on <u>dogfoodadvisor.com</u>. Our Health Guarantee requires choosing a <u>4-5 star dog food</u> WITH grains that is appropriate for the age of your puppy. You will receive what your puppy has been eating with us. We currently feed our pups Victor Select Chicken and Brown Rice formula AND Victor Classic Pro-Plus which have a 4.5-5 star rating on Dog Food Advisor.
- Avoid exposing your puppy to physically stressful situations, such as frequent stair climbing or standing on concrete for long periods of time during his formative years.
- Do not run with your puppy before 18 months and with your veterinarian's approval. Please educate yourself on safe running practices at this link: WHEN A DOG IS READY TO RUN
- Provide adequate shelter and make sure there is always fresh clean water available.
- Make sure your puppy has plenty of exercise on a regular basis, and whenever possible. Don't overdo it in the first few months as puppies need lots of rest too!
