
TWO-WAY CYCLE TRACKS

As part of the Downtown Billings Two-Way Restoration project, the City of Billings and Downtown Billings are adding two-way cycle tracks to North 31st Street and 3rd Avenue North.









Pedestrians: Use the designated pedestrian crossing and wait for the signal to cross. Please look both ways and watch for bicyclists and drivers turning right.

Bicyclists: Stay in the two-way cycle track when traveling through the intersection. Use the pedestrian signal to know when to stop or proceed. When turning from the cycle track, yield to pedestrians on the crosswalk.

Right-turning vehicles: Yield to pedestrians and bicyclists coming from both directions.
