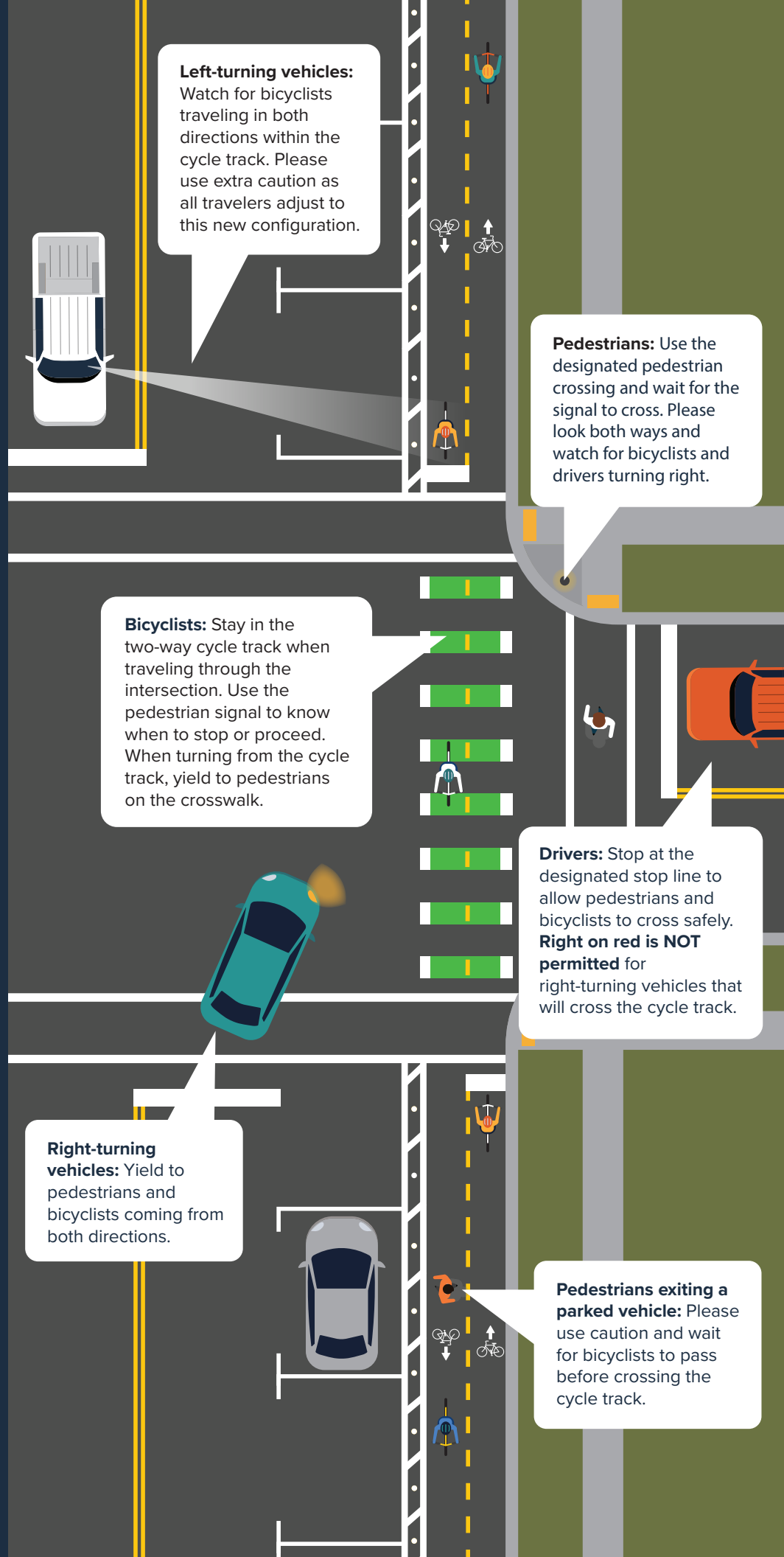


TWO-WAY CYCLE TRACKS

As part of the Downtown Billings Two-Way Restoration project, the City of Billings and Downtown Billings are adding two-way cycle tracks to **North 31st Street and 3rd Avenue North.**



Left-turning vehicles:

Watch for bicyclists traveling in both directions within the cycle track. Please use extra caution as all travelers adjust to this new configuration.

Pedestrians: Use the designated pedestrian crossing and wait for the signal to cross. Please look both ways and watch for bicyclists and drivers turning right.

Bicyclists: Stay in the two-way cycle track when traveling through the intersection. Use the pedestrian signal to know when to stop or proceed. When turning from the cycle track, yield to pedestrians on the crosswalk.

Drivers: Stop at the designated stop line to allow pedestrians and bicyclists to cross safely. **Right on red is NOT permitted** for right-turning vehicles that will cross the cycle track.

Right-turning vehicles: Yield to pedestrians and bicyclists coming from both directions.

Pedestrians exiting a parked vehicle: Please use caution and wait for bicyclists to pass before crossing the cycle track.
