### Report on 15 computers received from Loving Arms Liberia Introduction

"Work Hard. Be a Leader. Dream BIG."

Report on 15 computers received from Loving Arms Liberia LEAD Monrovia Football Academy (LEAD MFA) was established in 2015. LEAD MFA is the first school in Liberia to combine high-quality education with elite football training. The academy supports and nurtures all areas of our student's development and learning—from their academic proficiency in literacy, math, arts, and science, to their social-emotional skills, leadership abilities, and health and wellness. LEAD MFA also promotes gender equality to ensure girl shave the same opportunities for success as boys.

LEAD Monrovia Football Academy's model was designed to identify, recruit, and harness the potential of Liberia's most talented boys and girls. There is a severe lack of opportunities for Liberian youth to develop their talents and realize their full potential. Academic achievement is historically low, organized youth sport is virtually limited, and formal employment is 15%. As a result, youth are disenfranchised, and economic opportunities are limited. We aim to fill this opportunity gap by creating academic and athletic spaces in which Liberia's most dynamic young people can thrive. LEAD MFA is working to change these narratives by empowering Liberia's future leaders through all of its core programs.

Project and Impact

LEAD MFA received a total of 15 Lenovo laptops from the Loving Arms for Liberia Organization. We immediately decided to pilot a computer literacy program at our school. We had one of our teachers teach grades 7-11 every school day for forty- five minutes. This donation has contributed to enhancing computer literacy for students and leverage technology to improve educational outcomes. The pilot program taught us that there is a need to have a computer literacy program to ensure our students are adequately prepared with the relevant skills to transition from university to the workforce. As a result of this, we are working to expand the computer literacy program and develop a more robust curriculum for our students to be prepared for their digital future.

We remain grateful to the Loving Arms for Liberia Organization for its general support to improve access to computer literacy education for our student-athletes and we look forward to continuing our partnership.


