- A second scholarship will go to a senior whose parent or guardian is a member of IUOE Local 95 in its entirety.
- Instructions for this scholarship: Write a 500-word, double-spaced essay on ***Unionism and why it is necessary***. Place your name and Social Security Number in the upper right corner of each sheet of paper.

The **third** scholarship, in memory of Jacob Hoffman, will go to a Warren County School District graduating senior who plans to attend Trade School.

- Instructions for this scholarship: Write a 500-word double-spaced essay on ***Family and what it means to me***. Place your name and Social Security Number in the upper right corner of each sheet of paper.

Requirements:

- For the **first two** scholarships, an IUOE Local 95 union affiliation as noted above.
- For the **third** scholarship, graduation from WCSD with plans to attend a trade school.

For **ALL THREE** scholarships:

- A completed and signed application form.
- The application and essay ***must be postmarked by 5/1/2026***. It must be ***received by 5/8/2026***.
- No applications will be accepted without a postmark.

Extenuating circumstances:

Checks for the scholarship winners will be made out to the school of the recipient in the following manner: Payable to: (Name of school) for (Name of recipient). If, for any reason, the recipient does not attend a postsecondary school within six months of their high school graduation and the scholarship check has not been cashed, the scholarship will be returned to IUOE Local 95. Any returned checks may be awarded to another applicant. Where the check has not been cashed within six months due to illness or accident, the disposition of the scholarship may be delayed until such time as the recipient can attend school. However, if the recipient will not attend school or the delay will be longer than one (1) year from the issuance of the scholarship, the scholarship must be returned.
