- For ALL THREE scholarships:
- A completed and signed application form.
- The application and essay <u>must be postmarked</u> by <u>5/1/2025</u>. It must be <u>received by 5/9/2025</u>.
- No applications will be accepted without a postmark.

Extenuating circumstances:

Checks for the scholarship winners will be made out to the school of the recipient in the following manner: Payable to: (Name of school) for (Name of recipient). If for any reason the recipient does not attend a post secondary school within six months of their graduation from high school and the scholarship check has not been cashed, the scholarship will be returned to IUOE Local 95. Any returned checks may be awarded to another applicant. Where the check has not been cashed within six months due to illness or accident, the disposition of the scholarship may be delayed to such time as the recipient can attend school. However, if the recipient will not attend school or the delay will be longer than one (1) year from the issuance of the scholarship, the scholarship must be returned.
