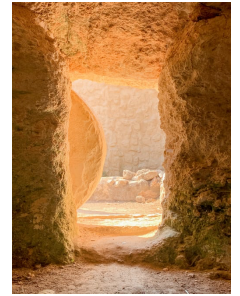


Healing Ministry

- Multi-layered narrative
- Impact of being one ‘whole’ story - not just Easter ‘bits’
- Embracing all of our human experience - Heb 4:15/16
- We are ‘whole’ and ‘interconnected’ creatures - 1 Thess 5:23
- Restoring Imago Dei to humanity



Five scenes from Passion week ~ ~ five moments of healing grace



Jesus’ ongoing ministry

- Pressure (internal and external)
- Disciples (ambition/relationships)
- Dealing with opposition (relentless/persistent)
- Awareness of the imminent Passover
- Holding the mission on course

Gethsemane 1: Mount of Olives

- Matt 26: 36-46
- Will - submission
- Emotions - self preservation/fight or flight
- The desire for confirmation and reassurance
- Mind - intensity beyond words/sweat like blood - Lk 22:44



Gethsemane 2: Mount of Olives

- Matt 26: 47-56
- Betrayal
- Wrongful arrest/injustice
- Concern for Malchus’ healing (Lk 22: 51)
- Concern for the disciples - Jn 18: 8
- Abandoned by the disciples/isolation

Session Two: Trials and Triumph



Trial - Sanhedrin

- Matt 26:57-68
- False accusation
- Coercion - confess (Matt 26:62-64)
- Torture/humiliation
- Denial by friends



The power of Rome

- Matt 27: 1-2 / 11-31
- Rendition
- Mock trial - failing justice system
- Torture/abuse - Praetorian guard/crown & sceptre
- Mockery/humiliation - this is what awaits you if you oppose Rome
- Beating/scourging - (Is 53:5)



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The power of the Cross

- Matt 27: 32-50
- Shame of public parading through the streets
- The first 'wine' refused
- The nails/the spear wound
- THE TEMPTATION! - He could have come down.



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The power of the Cross

- Matt 27: 32-50
- Despair/loneliness - Eloi Eloi...
- The second 'wine' received
- Concern for his mother & John! - Jn 19: 25-27
- Giving up his spirit: the ultimate act of faith!

- what we are 'full of' is met by what He is 'full of'

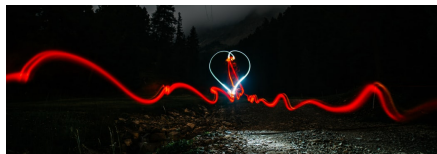
