The recycling shed is for aluminum can recycling only. It is found on the west end of the property. Thank you for your support.



# RECEPIE FOR THE MONTH JUNE MOCHA DESSERT

#### A cool and refreshing dessert for summer

Dissolve 2 tsp. instant coffee in 1 cp boiling water, then melt 16 oz of marshmallows in the hot liquid; let cool.

Whip 2 cups (or less) whipping cream (or use 2 cups cool whip) and stir in the cooled marshmallow mixture with 1 cup largely chopped nuts.

Add 1 tsp. vanilla and pour in 9" x 13" pan lined with vanilla wafer or graham cracker crumbs.

Sprinkle crumbs on top. Chill.

Serve each piece with a dollop of whipped cream and a maraschino cherry (optional).
