Rules for The Fairfield Iowa Renaissance Faire

Try to cover tent frames, tables, chairs, etc. * Try to have a sign. We know a maker!

To help, we are looking for local people who can make simple cloth sheathes for pop-up tent legs & ceiling frames so vendors can purchase unique affordable covers.

Each new year is an opportunity to improve your look.

I seriously shant:

"Won't the Don'ts"

- ❖ do the drugs, drink the booze, or inebriate herbally or in general <u>during fair hours</u>,
- ❖ light a <u>fire!</u> outside of a raised metal firepit, nor forget water or a fire extinguisher.
- be aggressively, passive-aggressively, or <u>generally rude</u> to patrons, rennies of any calling, or my own crew & kids (as much as I can help it) in the land of the FIRF.

- violate people's bodies or property; for example, I won't steal, hide, or break things, cross barriers, enter unoccupied structures, touch people (even casually) without permission, litter, or generally be a nuisance by ignoring verbal/basic social norms.
- ❖ <u>lift any skirts</u> as it violates both person, property, & potentially minors/bystanders.
- ❖ <u>lift any kilts</u> because IT'S THE SAME THING especially because a kilt worn with underpants under is technically a skirt & I will surely <u>wear underpants with my kilt.</u>
- ❖ <u>smoke</u> in front of patrons; even in my own tent I will exhale my electronic personal pleasure fumes into a handkerchief like proper gentry.

- bring drinking water jugs or jugs to fill as a fire extinguisher if I make a firepit fire.
- ❖ drive slowly, cautiously, only where allowed/directed, & never between 9:30a 6:30p.
- * keep the noise down to a neighborly level after 10pm and totally STFU by midnight.
- ❖ treat all folk with courtesy, avoid folk with whom I cannot, & not repeat rumors .
