In the Paint Your Own Pottery Studio you'll pick from a wide selection of pottery pieces such as plates, mugs, bowls and platters. Using the same tools and glazes as Stoneware's artisans, and after a quick tutorial, you'll decorate your masterpiece. Once complete, your piece will be glazed and fired by Stoneware staff and shipped to your home when it's ready. You will also have some free time to explore the **Paristown** area of Louisville, including lunch on your own which we suggest the **Village Market.** Enjoy food from around the world in Louisville's only food hall. From Filipino, to Mexican, to classic pizza and burgers, there is something for everyone to enjoy here. The Village Market also has a full service bar & donut shop. We will going back to the hotel for a little down time before we head to the **Derby Dinner Playhouse** for a production to **"Singin in the Rain".** Hollywood of the 1920's is the setting for this light-hearted and romantic MGM classic filled with show-stopping dance numbers and memorable music. Day 3-April 12

After breakfast this morning we're off to the Muhammad Ali Center. Located in the heart of historic downtown Louisville, Kentucky, the Muhammad Ali Center is a cultural attraction and international education center inspired by the ideals of hometown hero Muhammad Ali. The Ali Center features 2 levels of award-winning exhibits, a five-screen orientation theater film, historic Civil Rights era media footage, video of Ali fights, interactive boxing fun, two art galleries, children's Hope and Dream wall, meeting and event space, retail store and more. After our tour here and time for lunch on our own, we will tour the Frazier History Museum. The Frazier History Museum is where the world meets Kentucky. Explore cultures past and present thru an extensive collection of historical items displaying what makes Kentucky cool, famous weaponry, heated rivalries, historical information on America's native spirit Bourbon.
