Hedgehogs are back on the Park!

Tuesday 7th October 2025 was a momentous day for hedgehogs on Delamere Park!
Three wild rescued hedgehogs were 'donated' by **Northwich Hedgehog Rescue** and released in various locations around DP.



Helen Gill, who runs the rescue from her home in Northwich, brings rescued sick and injured 'hogs back to full health prior to their release back into the wild.

The release was supported by our FM Tim Cookson, with the locations being chosen by Helen, and my wife Liz and me.

Liz and I purchased three 'Hog Houses' from Helen for their release, and continue to monitor them and top up the food.

Maybe the 'hogs will choose to use them for hibernation this winter.

Five more Hog Houses were purchased by residents so hopefully the three released 'hogs (which are not related to each other) will integrate into their surroundings and breed with native Park 'hogs and boost our diminished hedgehog population.



Helen was very impressed by the hedgehog-friendly layout of the Park and the abundance of suitable habitats, and there is a good chance that more rescued 'hogs may be released here in the future.

Helen runs Northwich Hedgehog Rescue, a rescue service for the rehabilitation of our native wild hedgehogs. She runs it from her home near B&Q in Northwich, and relies entirely on donations (equipment, food, money, etc.) to fund her work, together with help from her small team of foster carers. Finally, **thank you** to those residents who are continuing to supply me with their used/unwanted newspapers, instead of putting them in the CWAC recycling bin. Liz and I then take them the Rescue for Helen and her foster carers to use as bedding for the hedgehogs in their pods during their rehabilitation. Please keep them coming, it's a much more useful way of recycling!
