This time of year, our concern is to get prepared for the upcoming cold weather season which includes:

- Boiler room inspection and servicing to promote energy saving and prevent emergency repair costs
- Contacted the snow removal company, using the same company as last year since they did a good job and because we bought salt in bulk last year, we will not need to purchase any this year.
- A walk-thru of the parsonage was performed, there are no major repairs needed at this time. Pastor and his family are taking good care of the home.
- Will be scheduling a fall yard clean-up to prepare the grounds by trimming & storing planters etc.
- One topic for our next meeting is if we should keep the AED. The annual costs for batteries/pads are approx. \$140. During an inspection with the fire chief, he indicated that because they are so close, if we called 911, they would likely be here before we could use the machine...
