- All bills are paid to date.
- The 2024 proposed budget for Trinity voted &

passed by the Charge Conference is \$91,400 per year, (down \$30G from last year) weekly average is \$1757.

- Together with Pastor Diggs, the Finance Committee put together and published a fundraising calendar in January for the 2024 year. The Bake-less Bake Sale scheduled for July brought in \$990 for our Insurance Fund. Many thanks to all who responded to this appeal.
