



Throughout the past few weeks, Bohicket Marina has been carefully monitoring the ever evolving situation with COVID-19. As always, the safety of our staff and guests is our main priority. Along with the directions made by the CDC and WHO, we have taken the following necessary precautions to ensure our staff and guests safety to reduce the spread of this virus.

1. Starting today, March 23rd 2020, our offices will be closed to the public until further notice. There will be personnel on site to monitor the marina but will have no personal interaction with the customers. Please call our office to inquire about charters or with any other administrative needs.
2. Our fuel dock will be open and fueling will be done by the customer under the supervision of the staff.
3. Our dry stack operation will still be in use and our staff will be wearing gloves during the launching and retrieving process.
4. Frequent touched surfaces such as doorknobs, keypads and restroom facilities will be sanitized throughout the day to reduce the spread of viruses.

At the moment, the marina will still be open from 8 am to 5 pm, its normal business hours, but will be working with limited staffing on site. Please allow ample time for us to respond via email or phone as it may not be immediate. We appreciate your cooperation during this difficult time and pray that everyone and their families stay safe.
