

SCHOOL PERFORMANCE STATISTICS

(As Reported to NACCAS)



The Statistics above are for our 2021 NACCAS Annual Report. This reflects the most current NACCAS (National Accrediting Commission of Career Arts and Sciences) Annual Report Cohort Grid, which calculates our Performance Statistics for the most recent evaluation period (Calendar Year 2020). These Statistics are calculated Annually and reported to NACCAS in our required Annual Report. We are required to be factual in our submissions or risk withdrawal/denial of accreditation. These are the only Performance Statistics related to our Three Performance Criteria above that we are allowed to advertise. We are currently in the process of pursuing accreditation by NACCAS.

Annual NACCAS Performance Requirements

Regina Benton School of Cosmetology strives to provide the best Cosmetology educational experience available. We are pursuing Accreditation by the National Accrediting Commission of Career Arts and Sciences (NACCAS), but currently are not an accredited school. The process is lengthy and very detailed. We hope to acquire accreditation in the very near future. But during the process, we have to provide this data to NACCAS and potential students as a means to evaluate our performance versus other schools.

Their minimum requirements for the three areas of a School's Performance Criteria are:

-Graduation ------ Minimum 50% Rate NACCAS Requirement

The Graduation Rate is derived by the ratio of the number of students scheduled to graduate during the evaluation period and the actual number of students graduating. The graduation rate includes students that withdraw or are terminated for whatever reason.

-Licensure ------ Minimum 70% Rate NACCAS Requirement

The Licensure Rate is derived by the ratio of the number of students that Graduate who sat through both the Theory and Practical State Board Licensure Exams during the evaluation period and the actual number of these students that passed <u>Both</u> Theory and Practical Exams and received their licensure from the SC State Board of Cosmetology

-Placements ------ Minimum 60% Rate NACCAS Requirement

The Placement Rate is derived by the ratio of the number of students that graduate during the evaluation period and the actual number of these students that become employed in the Cosmetology Industry.
