FIRST THOUGHTS...

God creates man (humans) male or female from the very beginning. Gender is a word that was applied to biological sex about 50 years ago and has multiple meanings... up until that point we used the word sex to explain that we are either male or female. Our sex (male or female) is in every part of our body! Yes, it's in the genes* that determine whether we have girl or boy reproductive* organs, but it's also in the genes of our brains, muscles, hair, eyes, heart, etc.! Isn't that wild!? If you lost a single hair on your head, someone would be able to look at the DNA of that hair and tell whether you are male or female. We are all human, and we all have a soul; we are all gifts! But our male and female differences are to be celebrated as well; they help us create new life, and they bring a fullness of emotional* and physical* gifts to the world.

DID YOU KNOW

If you are a girl, EVERY CELL in your body is designed to have two X chromosomes (XX). If you are a boy, EVERY CELL in your body is designed to have one X and one Y chromosome (XY). So, even your heart, brain, skin, kidney, and bone cells are marked as a girl or boy cell.

ONLY THE FEMALE HUMAN BODY IS DESIGNED TO BRING NEW LIFE INTO THE WORLD... WHAT A GIFT!

Male brains typically use 7x more gray matter for activity, while female brains use nearly 10x more white matter. Gray matter areas are information and action-processing centers in specific areas. This can translate to a focused vision when boys are doing something. White matter is the networking grid that connects the brain's gray matter areas with one another. The graywhite matter difference may explain why, in adulthood, females are typically great multi-taskers, while males often excel in highly task-focused projects.
