

FIRST THOUGHTS...

Many children will grow up and get married. Some will feel called to become a religious sister, brother, or priest. The Sacrament* of Matrimony (marriage) and the Sacrament of Holy Orders (priesthood, diaconate) are holy and fruitful* in many ways. Some people will not feel called to these choices and will experience a yearning* in their hearts outside of marriage + holy orders. They might be called to live as people who consecrate* their bodies + souls to God, or as religious brothers or sisters. Within marriage, couples are called to be open to life and to welcome children from God. People who cannot have their own biological children can fulfill* their call to parenthood through adoption or as spiritual parents. They might open their home to foster children or provide care in other ways to people. All people are called to honor God with the work of their hands and to listen to His voice when discerning* a career or primary vocation as a parent. If we listen closely, we may find out that the career God sees for us is different than the one we see for ourselves! We will explore careers in a future issue.




Draw yourself as a married person (husband or wife)


