



Golf Course Etiquette and Safety



GOLF COURSE AND ETIQUETTE RULES: While we are privileged to have easy access to the golf course, homeowners and guests are reminded that the golf course is not available for walking and other enjoyment in the morning after the cart path chains are down or again until the end of the playing day when the chains are again in place. Typically, the course is considered closed for golfing when all flags have been removed and the cart pathways are closed by chains at the road access points. Please avoid risk of injury by following access rules. Additionally, dogs should be leashed and in control of a human at all times while on the golf course grounds. All dog waste should also be removed and disposed of properly. Dog waste bags should not be left on the golf course.

GOLF COURSE SAFETY: Homeowners and guests are advised to be mindful and aware of active golfers and golf ball flight when on, near, or around the golf course. It is not uncommon for a golf ball to quickly fly off course and hit townhome properties including, windows, decks, common space and buildings. People and pets can be at risk for injury if not attentive to their surroundings when on or near the golf course.
