### Stage 4 Fire Restrictions (6/23/2021)

<p><b>FUTS Closures</b> Sections of the Flagstaff Urban Trails System that provide an entrance into the Coconino National Forest are closed, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mars Hill Trail</li> <li>• Tunnel Springs Trail</li> <li>• Little America Loop</li> <li>• Arizona Trail</li> <li>• Sinclair Wash Trail</li> <li>• Pipeline Trail</li> <li>• Switzer Canyon Trial</li> <li>• Sheeps Crossing off Pulliam Trail</li> </ul>	<p><b>Fire Pits</b> Open fire pits and open flame devices (even those with a spark arrestor screen) are prohibited.</p> <p><b>BBQs</b> All outdoor grills (even those with an on/off switch) are prohibited.</p> <p><b>Fireworks</b> The sale or use of consumer-grade fireworks within the city is prohibited.</p>
<p><b>Open Space Closures</b> Public entry without prior city authorization of the following city open space lands is prohibited:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Observatory Mesa</li> <li>• Picture Canyon City Open Space</li> </ul>	<p><b>Smoking</b> Smoking in all public places is prohibited.</p> <p><b>Burn Permits</b> No permits are issued for open burning within the city.</p>
