Amun Ini Beach Resort & Spa: Nestled in Anda, Bohol, this secluded haven spans a three-hectare beachfront property with a private white-sand cove. The resort features 16 deluxe rooms with private terraces and ocean views. Amenities include an infinity pool, an on-site restaurant offering gourmet cuisine with locally sourced ingredients, and a spa specializing in traditional 'hilot' massages. The on-site dive center provides access to over 30 dive sites within a 10-minute boat ride, showcasing pristine coral reefs and diverse marine life. - **Accommodation:** 6 nights in a deluxe room, suite, or penthouse.
- **Transfers:** Dumaguete Airport to resort, and Ocean Jet fast ferry (business class).
- **Dining:** Full board at Dahon Restaurant, including breakfast, 2-course lunch, afternoon tea, and 3-course dinner
- **Diving:** 15 dives total: 14 regular dives and 1-night dive, encompassing boat rides, tanks, weights, dive guides, marine park fees, and a day trip to Apo Island for three dives. Nitrox is provided for all dives.

Trip Requirements

- All divers must be certified and have dive insurance such as DAN (Divers Alert Network)
- Divers must review our information regarding diving with Shared Adventure Tours.

What you need to know before diving with us

- You must be in good health. If you have a condition that could require you to answer "yes" to any of the questions on the health form, you will need a doctor's sign-off. Medical Form
- Your gear must be serviced before you leave. Please take it to a reputable shop to ensure it is in proper working condition. We cannot guarantee that the resort will be able to service your gear if a problem occurs.
- We strongly recommend that you understand how your dive computer operates. While we can help with many, we are not familiar with all. Make sure you bring the instruction manual.
- Refresh your skills - If it has been a while since you have been in the water, schedule a Scuba Review with a dive shop.
- Understand the type of diving we will be doing—Most of our trips are for all levels of diver, but some will require more experience and training. We do our best to provide that information in our travel information session. If you are in doubt whether a trip is appropriate, please ask, and we can review it with you.
- Dive within your limitations—Some of the dives on the trip may be beyond your comfort level. If you are uncomfortable, let us and the divemaster's know.
- We require that you abide by the PADI Safe Diving Practices, which we will review with you. Safety is our number one priority when diving, and we enforce the PADI Safe Diving Practices.
- We enforce buddy diving - All divers must have a buddy and abide by buddy diving rules. Traveling single? No problem. Let us know if you need a buddy, and we will make sure you have one.



Risks, Liabilities, and Assumption of Risk

All travel and adventure activities involve risks. Participants must understand these risks, the locations we will visit, and the activities we will participate in. We will do our best to explain these risks and require participants to sign liability releases, including the Shared Adventure Tours Release of Liability.

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
