Trip Requirements

- We require all divers to use a dive computer
- All divers must be certified and have dive insurance such as DAN (Divers Alert Network)
- Divers must review our information regarding diving with Shared Adventure Tours.

What you need to know before diving with us

- You must be in good health. If you have a condition which could require you to answer "yes" to any of the questions on the health form, you will need a Doctor's sign off. Medical Form
- Your gear must be serviced before you leave. Take your gear to a reputable shop to ensure it is in proper working condition. We cannot guarantee the resort will have the ability to service your gear if a problem is encountered.
- We strongly recommend that you understand how your dive computer operates. While we can help with many, we are not familiar with all. Make sure you bring the instruction manual.
- Refresh your skills If it has been a while since you have been in the water, schedule a Scuba Review with a dive shop.
- Understand the type of diving we will be doing Most of our trips are for all levels of diver, but some will require more experience and training. We do our best to provide that information in our travel information session. If in doubt whether a trip is appropriate, please ask and we can review with you.
- Dive within your limitations Some of the dives on the trip could be out of your comfort level. Never hesitate to let us and the divemasters know if you are not comfortable.
- We require that you abide by the PADI Safe Diving Practices which we will review with you Safety is our number one priority when diving. We enforce the PADI Safe Diving Practices.
- We enforce buddy diving All divers must have a buddy and abide by buddy diving rules. Traveling single? No problem. Let us know if you need a buddy and we will make sure you have one.
