Risks, Liabilities and Assumption of Risk

Day 1, March 6, 2021 – Transfer from Jucaro to Havana

- Check in at the Hotel Parque Central
- Dinner on your own (Tour Guide we can reserve the restaurant, and a representative will go with group)

Day 2, March 7, 2021 - Havana City Tour

- Central Havana Driving Tour - Havana is considered one of the most architecturally diverse cities in the world. Travel down Prado Street and see El Capitolio, inspired by the US Capitol building, and the Gran Teatro de Habana, home of the National Ballet and the National Opera. You will also see the facades of the National Museum of Fine Arts and the Museum of the Revolution, which is the former Presidential Palace. Dialogue with your local guide to learn more about this area.
- Old Havana - A UNESCO World Heritage Site - "Studded with architectural jewels spanning five centuries, Habana Vieja (Old Havana) enchants visitors with one of the finest ensembles of urban edifices in the Americas" - (lahabana.com). As you walk through the four historic plazas, you will interact with Cuban performers and vendors and meet many of the locals along the way. You will also see the Palace of the Captain's General at the Plaza de Armas, which is now the Museum of the City of Havana.
- Visit La Bodeguita del Medio, one of Hemingway's favorite places.
- Lunch at Mediterraneo
- Modern Havana - Travel through the diverse areas of the city including the Miramar district, the Malecon and the Vedado district. Engage with your local guide to understand the history of these areas.
- Plaza de la Revolución - visit the José Martí Memorial. Many of the local classic car owners congregate here and you will have an opportunity to interact with them as you admire their automotive works of art. It has taken great ingenuity to keep these cars running for over 50 years!
- Return to the hotel and end of driver/guide service. Free night at leisure. Dinner on your own

Day 3, March 8, 2021 - Havana City Tour

- Continue the Tour of the City.
- Cigar Factory Tour - Considered to be the best in the world, watch the cigar rollers as they continue this centuries-old tradition
- Morro Castle and La Cabaña Fortress - Dialogue with the locals as you see this famous fortress that guards the entrance to Havana Bay.
- Lunch at La Fontana
- Fusterlandia - José Fuster's Community Project - Visit the home and community project of the famed artist Jose Fuster, known as "Picasso of the Caribbean". You can also purchase Jose Fuster's art. Meet the locals in the neighborhood and see their artistic homes and discuss the revitalization of their neighborhood and the impact of this project on the community.
- San José Craft Market - This local art and crafts market is on the Port of Havana, and you will see the works of many local artists, along with some of the Cuban items that are made by local craftsmen.
- Return to the hotel. Free night at leisure. Dinner on your own
