

### ABOUT THE PROJECT

Swindon Motorsports, a joint venture between Swindon Speedway and Gaming International, has developed plans for a new motorsports hub on land at Studley Grange, Wiltshire, near Junction 16 of the M4.

The site is located 3.3 miles south-west of Swindon and 2.3 miles south-east of Royal Wootton Bassett.

The new facility will provide a long-term future for speedway racing in Swindon with the development of a multi-use site which is commercially viable and suitable for a wider range of commercial, business, and leisure uses.

Following the completion of the consultation report, we will submit a planning application to Wiltshire Council, the Local Planning Authority, in accordance with the provisions of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990. A decision on whether to grant planning will then be determined by councillors at Wiltshire Council.

We anticipate a decision from Wiltshire Council in 2025.

We have now launched a public consultation on our draft proposals which runs from Wednesday 29 January to Sunday 23 February 2025.



- A multi-use events arena with an expandable capacity of up to 3,000 for special events

- · 200 car parking spaces, including EV charging points
- Facilities for refreshments and entertainment including food and beverage outlets
