



PUNJAB FLOODS & RELIEF

Punjab, the land of five rivers and the very rich state in its agriculture produce, colorful cultural heritage and its highest contribution during Indian independence and ever ready to provide assistance, wherever disaster arises but now Punjab is reeling under one of its worst floods in decades, with widespread crop devastation reported in 175,216 hectares of land. Over 1,655 villages have been inundated, affecting a population of 355,709 people across 23 districts. The most severely affected districts include Gurdaspur, Amritsar, Kapurthala, Hoshiarpur, and Ferozepur.

Causes of the Floods:

Heavy monsoon rainfall in the upper catchment areas of Himachal Pradesh and Jammu & Kashmir

Water releases from dams like Pong, Ranjit Sagar, and Bhakra

Climate change leading to increased intensity and unpredictability of monsoon rains

Effects of the Floods:

Crop Damage: 175,216 hectares of standing crops have been damaged, with Gurdaspur suffering losses over 40,169 hectares

Displacement: Over 20,000 people have been evacuated, with 5,304 people currently sheltered in 167 relief camps

Loss of Life: The death toll has risen to 43, with the highest casualties reported in Hoshiarpur, Pathankot, Barnala, and Amritsar

Infrastructure Damage: Roads, bridges, and government buildings have been damaged or destroyed, disrupting connectivity and trade

Relief Efforts:

KHALSA AiD, AKAL ACCADEMY, along with many other Sikh Organisations, all over the world have started with rescue operations and providing shelter, food, medicines and necessary items for daily needs. The Punjab government has launched rescue operations, deploying gazetted officers in every flood-affected village to ensure direct coordination and effective relief operations

Relief Camps: 167 relief camps have been set up across the state, providing shelter, food, and medical aid to affected people

Compensation: The government has announced compensation for families of victims and farmers who have suffered crop losses, with payments expected to begin before Diwali.

Compensation Details:

Crop Damage Relief:

- Rs 20,000 per acre for 75-100% crop loss
- Rs 10,000 per acre for 26-75% crop damage

Houses: Rs 1.20 lakh for completely damaged homes

Land Erosion: Rs 47,500 per hectare for farms washed away by rivers

The Punjab Assembly has sought a special flood relief package of Rs 20,000 crore from the Center to compensate farmers, rebuild damaged infrastructure, and restore livelihoods in flood-affected regions.

In spite of all these calamities and nature's disaster, the spirit of Punjabis & Punjabiya is not lost, and we are very sure that positive Punjabis will definitely bounce back very soon with love and support from all over the world.




